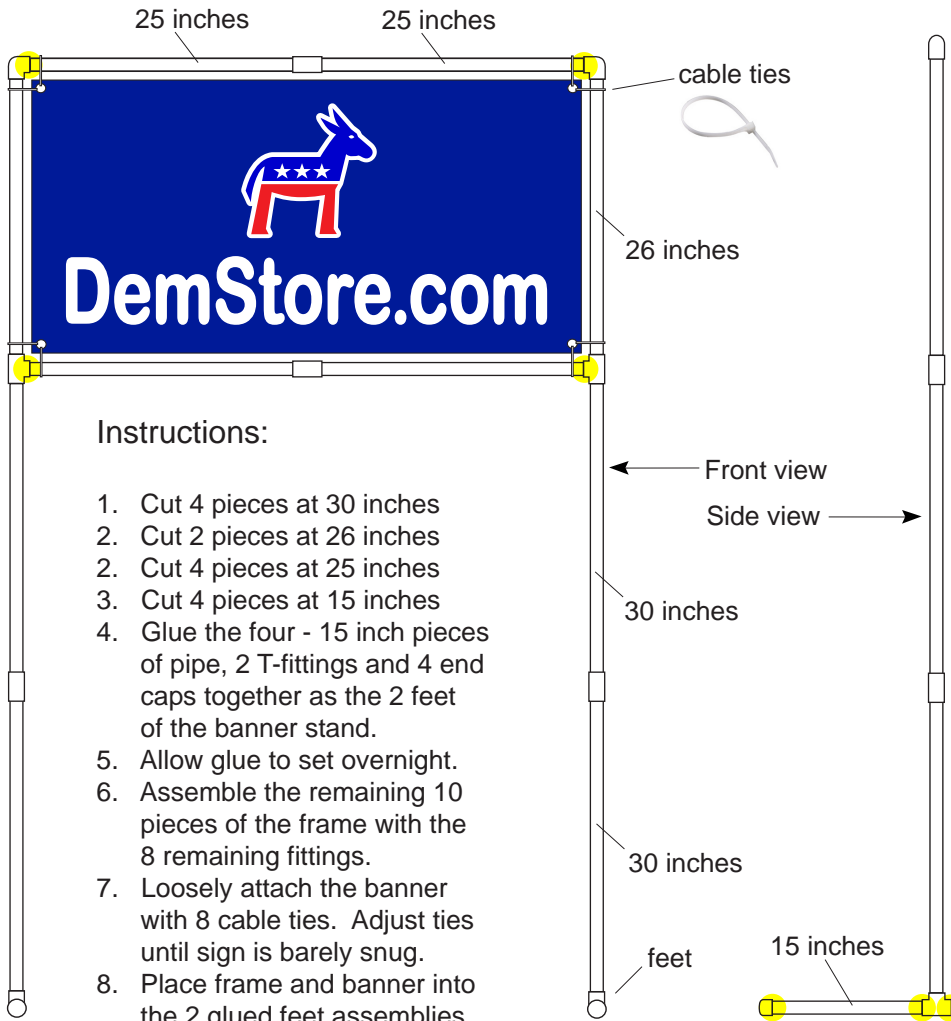


# Freestanding Banner Display

For 2 x 4 foot banners. Great for Tabling, House Parties, Rallies and Fundraisers.



Use a large draw string laundry bag to store the unassembled stand and banner. Roll the 2 - 26 inch pieces up inside your banner to separate them from the 4 - 25 inch pieces and 4 - 30 inch leg pieces. It will be easier to reassemble the stand.



## Instructions:

1. Cut 4 pieces at 30 inches
2. Cut 2 pieces at 26 inches
2. Cut 4 pieces at 25 inches
3. Cut 4 pieces at 15 inches
4. Glue the four - 15 inch pieces of pipe, 2 T-fittings and 4 end caps together as the 2 feet of the banner stand.
5. Allow glue to set overnight.
6. Assemble the remaining 10 pieces of the frame with the 8 remaining fittings.
7. Loosely attach the banner with 8 cable ties. Adjust ties until sign is barely snug.
8. Place frame and banner into the 2 glued feet assemblies.

## Tools:

- PVC glue (cement)
- Measuring tape
- Sharpie marker
- Hacksaw



## Materials:

- 3 - 10 ft. pieces of 1/2 inch PVC pipe
  - 2 - 1/2 inch elbows
  - 4 - 1/2 inch T-fittings
  - 4 - 1/2 inch barrel fittings
  - 4 - 1/2 inch end caps
  - 8 - 10 inch cable ties
- approximately \$10

## Tips:

Glue only the joints highlighted in yellow so you can take the stand apart and bundle and store it easily.

You may need to add weight on the feet to secure the sign if it is displayed outside. (backpacks)

Use colored or clear Duct tape to reinforce the gromets in each corner of your banner.
